**Classes:** 1 - 30cm (12 and under only.)      4 - 90cm  
2 - 50cm      5 - 110cm  
3 - 70cm  
AM7 . Power and Speed . Top Score

Riders of any age may compete in classes 2-5 providing that both horse and rider are fit to compete.

## Terms and Conditions of Entry

- This event will be run under PCAQ rules, which riders must adhere to at all times.
- There are strictly **NO DOGS** allowed on the grounds. Any dogs found on the grounds may be asked to be removed.
- For the safety reasons, stallions or rigs will not be allowed on the grounds.
- The cross country course will be closed to all competitors. Any riders found jumping the cross country jumps may be eliminated.
- The organising committee reserves the right to a) cancel any class or event, b) to divide or alter classes, c) to refuse entry with or without reason, d) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.
- The organising committee does not accept the responsibility of any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse(s) or person(s) on the grounds.
- Partial refunds for scratching may be made if the organisers are notified before the close of nominations.
- In the event that the competition is cancelled, the organising committee may retain a 10% amendment fee.
- Protests must be made in writing within 30 minutes of results being posted.

**Back Numbers** are available from the canteen area with a \$5 deposit. Alternatively bridle numbers may be worn so long as they are clearly visible.
